Investment Philosophy

- ◆ Our job is to know the investment world and to design a portfolio to meet the various needs of our clients.
- ◆ We balance our client's goals with their risk tolerance and timeframe to recommend the most appropriate mix of assets to achieve growth, income, or preservation.
- ◆ We do not manage our performance against a particular index, but rather against the goals that we have discussed with our clients.

Investment Process

- ◆ We begin with the purpose of the investment, and the timeframe — how long it will be invested before it will need to be liquidated or to produce income.
- ◆ Next we determine the ideal tax characteristics of the account, based on current income and assumptions about future income.
- ◆ After we choose the investment program with the most appropriate benefits, we focus our client's risk/return parameters, which may vary within a portfolio.
- ◆ Each portfolio is individually structured and continuously monitored.

- ◆ Globally diversified discretionary portfolios incorporating *Aladdin*, BlackRock's proprietary risk management overlay
 - ◆ International and domestic equity and fixed income
 - ◆ Alternative asset sleeves
